

Pastor's Letter: Oct 6, 2024 Twenty Seventh Sunday In Ordinary Time

The Family Is Our Connection To God

The start of the first book of the Bible, the Book of Genesis, always reminds us that it was God who created man. Then God made woman as a partner for man.

When Adam sees the woman he says, "This one, at last, is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; this one shall be called 'woman." Logically, God desires that man and woman should become one. The first Sunday of October is designated as Respect Life Sunday.



Published by Catholic Charities USA, *Whole Hearted* provides information about trauma and helps you privately reflect on your own experience.

Trauma is defined as a disruption of one's normal physical, mental, emotional or social ability due to big, small, ordinary or extraordinary experiences or situations.

Though we will gather in community, *Whole Hearted* is not a support group nor is it a clinical resource. It is "quiet" program that consists mainly of private journal exercises and short, small group discussions for those who wish to briefly share their own experiences.

All participants receive a free Whole Hearted journal, which:

- Provides sound mental health information on trauma
- Integrates our Catholic spirituality
- Enables private reflection on your personal responses to trauma
- Introduces practices that can help you and/or loved ones move forward




