Session 3: *Renaissance, Reformation and the Catholic Restoration (to 1789)* -January 8- February 12 (NO CLASS 1/15) Faith and Reason; Reformation Theology & Catholic Response; Sacraments; Mission & Evangelization

Session 4: **Enlightenment & Modernity** - February 26 – March 25 Navigating the Effects of the Reformation & Enlightenment; Modernism; Apparitions; Early Liturgical Movement

Session 5: *The Church Today: Vatican II and beyond* - April 8 – May 6 Vatican II; Morality; Catholic Social Teaching; Universal Call to Holiness; Liturgy; Synods
